BUMBLEBEES, BIRDS AND WILDLIFE

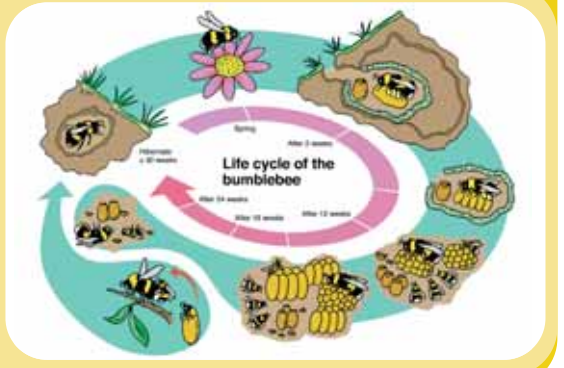

- The sound of Bees at work in the garden is one of the most pleasurable sounds of the summer, so take a look at the unique Just Green live Bumblebee hives.
- Watch and learn from our amazing insect breeding kits, including Ladybirds, Butterflies, Stick insects and Silk Worms.
- Install your own insect houses and bird boxes in the garden, made in the UK by our very own carpenters using 100% FSC approved timber.



BUMBLEBEE COLONIES

It is now possible to populate your garden or wildlife area with live Bumblebee colonies. Enjoy watching live Bees with JUST GREEN Bumblebee hives. The life cycle of the Bumblebee colony is only one season, so each colony lasts one season but new Queens are produced, leaving the colony in the autumn to set up new nests elsewhere the following year.



JUST TRADITIONAL BEE NEST (SMALL GARDEN HIVE)

This version of the **JUST TRADITIONAL BEE NEST** is designed for smaller gardens or for placing in fruit cages or vegetable plots. The wooden bee house contains a fully functional bee colony. This colony can be replaced with a new colony infill each season. The wooden bee house roof is hinged so that the bee colony within can be observed.

JUST TRADITIONAL BEE NEST (LARGE GARDEN HIVE)

This Bumblebee nest is housed in a traditional wooden bee house. This attractive bee hive design incorporates a live Bumblebee colony, which can be replaced each year. The roof of the hive can be opened for easy viewing of the colony contained within. This is fascinating for children and adults alike. Bumblebees can also be observed flying in and out of the hive through special entry and exit holes. The hive is supplied in a natural wood form or painted white. The wooden bee house can also be used as a garden store in the winter:

WILDLIFE HABITATS

JUST GREEN now produces and supplies a wide range of handcrafted, wooden mammal and insect habitats for encouraging and establishing beneficial insects and mammals in gardens. All made in our U.K. workshops, these attractive and solid designs create the perfect conditions for drawing some of nature's most welcome insects and mammals into gardens. All of our products are made from Forest Stewardship Council approved timber plantations.



JUST BAT BOX

Bats are fascinating creatures and have a long life if living in the right conditions. They are useful for controlling mosquitoes and gnats, which they track with their sophisticated hearing system. Bats are also a protected species in the U.K. The **JUST BAT BOX** is designed to be fitted onto trees, posts or houses and provides the ideal conditions for bats to roost in. The design incorporates an access ladder with grooves, which the bats can grip. The box should be sited 2-5 metres from the ground. If you are having more than one bat box, face in different directions; facing South East and South West. There should also be a clear flight path in front of the boxes. Place near to night-scented plants to attract night flying insects. Bats also like to be near water; where mosquito larvae are hatching, so place near ponds or slow moving streams if possible.



JUST BENEFICIAL INSECT HABITAT

Improve the biodiversity and wildlife in your garden with the **JUST BENEFICIAL INSECTS HABITAT**. This solid wooden habitat is designed to help attract a variety of beneficial insects to your garden including: solitary bees (for improving pollination and fruit yields), ladybirds (adults and their larvae eat greenfly), lacewings (larvae eat greenfly and other pests). Place the habitat near nectar/pollen bearing plants, which will attract bees and ladybirds. It can be free standing or attached to a fence or wall.

JUST BUMBLEBEE NEST

As a compliment or alternative to our "live" nest, we also offer a Bumblebee nest. Help wild Queen Bumblebees to establish in your garden by providing an ideal environment for her to nest. The nest includes nesting material for the Bumblebee Queen, a viewing panel, which can be looked through on opening, has a hinged roof and an information leaflet on Bumblebees. Place the hive in the garden in early spring to attract the Queen Bumblebees who have been in hibernation. Site the hive in a sheltered spot out of direct sunlight in a south facing position.

JUST BUTTERFLY HABITAT

Many species of butterfly need a place to spend the winter or hibernate. Some require a site to complete the chrysalis transformation stage and at least one species may use the habitat to lay eggs in. The **JUST BUTTERFLY HABITAT** provides a suitable environment for these periods in the butterfly life cycle. The habitat design includes special ramps or ledges, which are important for butterflies to warm their wings on prior to flight. Place the habitat on the side of a tree or fence, in a sheltered location that receives plenty of sunlight.

JUST DORMOUSE HABITAT

Dormice spend their day sleeping in nests and are nocturnal. They spend up to three quarters of their life asleep and hibernate from October to April. Their food sources are insects, seeds and fruits. Dormice are found in hedgerows, deciduous woodland with scrub and coppiced woodland. They are good climbers and spend much time in the tree canopy. The loss of suitable habitats has caused a serious decline in their numbers in the U.K. and are now protected in Britain by law. The **JUST**

DORMOUSE HABITAT can be placed in any hedgerow, near to a base of a tree in a secluded spot. Make sure nesting material such as twigs, bark, grass and moss is available close by.

JUST FROG & TOAD HOUSE

Frogs and toads both eat slugs and other insects such as caterpillars, snails and ants. For this reason and the fact that they are an interesting addition to any garden, it is useful to place a frog and toad habitat in the garden.

The habitat provides shelter from predators and cold weather. Frogs tend to hibernate near ponds in damper conditions and toads in dryer conditions. The habitat can be placed anywhere in the garden that is sheltered, offering either damp or dry conditions. Rotting leaves placed under the habitat will encourage frogs or toads to the habitat.

JUST LADYBIRD HOUSE

Help increase the number of ladybirds in your garden by providing adequate roosting spots with the **JUST LADYBIRD HOUSE**. The sloping front of the house is specially designed to encourage ladybird adults to enter and may also attract other beneficial insects like lacewings, both useful predators of greenfly and blackfly.

JUST HEDGEHOG HOUSE

Hedgehogs are carnivorous and have a wide ranging appetite from beetles to tinned pet food, if meat based. They are also a useful predator of slugs. If feeding small hedgehogs, only use goat's milk and provide a bowl of water. Hedgehogs breed in May and the young hedgehogs remain in their nest/house until June or July. Hedgehogs need a house or habitat to:

- overwinter and hibernate
- provide a safe environment for both adult and young hedgehogs
- shelter in the summer from bad weather and predators such as foxes.

Some hedgehogs are killed when they choose to hibernate in bonfires, or unsafe places like sheds or garages where garden pesticides may be present. The **JUST HEDGEHOG HOUSE**



features a sealable hinged lid to allow cleaning access outside of hibernation periods, ventilation holes in the rear; and a tunnel in the front to encourage entry for hedgehogs and prevent predators getting in! Place in a sheltered spot with leaves placed on and around the house with straw/grass inside to encourage nesting.

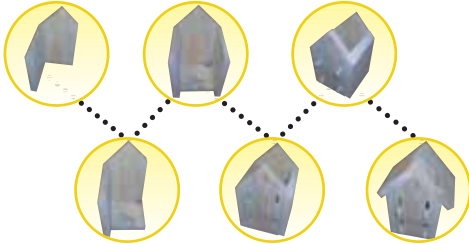

JUST BUTTERFLY PRODUCTION KIT

Watch and learn as caterpillars grow and change into beautiful butterflies with the **JUST BUTTERFLY BREEDING KIT**. This unique kit allows children and adults to marvel at the life cycle of these fascinating insects. Whilst the young caterpillars feed on a special diet, children can watch and record the growth of the caterpillars as they develop through their life stages. The kit can be used as a teaching aid or just an amazing method for producing beautiful insects for release into the home garden.

BIRDCARE

Insect eating birds are a very valuable source of natural pest control; Blackbirds and Thrushes search out slugs and snails to eat in the garden, Blue Tits eat hundreds of caterpillars and Green Woodpeckers will eat ants in the grass of lawns. These benefits and the pleasure we derive from observing birds are not ones that should be taken for granted. Some wildbird populations are in serious decline. Providing a suitable environment and feeding birds

can help reverse this process. JUST GREEN has now developed a whole range of natural products to help and support wild birds in your garden;

JUST NEST BOXES

The decline in woodland areas and older trees means there are fewer nesting sites for over 60 species of birds, which use old trees for their nests. Putting up an artificial nest box will help future generations of birds and give much enjoyment as you watch birds using them. Nest boxes are best put up in the autumn. JUST GREEN has developed a range of nests for various garden and wildbirds. Some species of birds will use a nest depending on the size of the hole on the front and others require an open front. All JUST GREEN made nests also incorporate drainage holes, as it is important nests are not waterlogged or too damp. The siting of the nest box is important and guidelines are provided with the product description in this catalogue.



JUST ROBIN NEST

The JUST ROBIN NEST is an open fronted box suitable for Robins and Wrens. Being open fronted it is easy to view but can be vulnerable to predators, so site low down (below 2m) and position in vegetation for cover:

The JUST BIRD BOX 25mm is suitable for Blue Tits, Coal and Marsh Tits. Site the box so that the birds have a clear flight path, without any clutter in front of the box and at a height of between 2-4 metres on a tree or wall.
