

GUIDELINES FOR Fungus Fly Killer

The Solution:



FUNGUS FLY KILLER contains the nematode, *Steinernema feltiae*. These tiny parasitic nematodes kill the larvae of Fungus flies. These nematodes will also attack other soil or compost dwelling larvae such as thrip larvae. Each pack contains 6 million nematodes

IMPORTANT GUIDELINES FOR THE CORRECT USE OF FUNGUS FLY KILLER

- **FUNGUS FLY KILLER** will treat an area of twelve square metres of compost or 120 x 10 litre pots.
- Apply **FUNGUS FLY KILLER** every 4 weeks for preventative control or as soon as fungus fly adults or larvae are observed.
- The compost or soil temperature needs to be above 13°C
- Open the packet of **FUNGUS FLY KILLER** and empty the contents into a watering can and mix thoroughly. One packet should be mixed in 10 litres of water.
- Stir well and leave solution to soak for five minutes.
- Stir again and apply all the solution to the compost or soil to be treated.
- Compost or soil should be moist [not soaking] at time of application and kept moist for two weeks after application.
- Avoid using a watering can rose with a fine grade. Use a coarse or medium one or not at all.
- **DO NOT USE PESTICIDES** before or after application without checking to see if they are harmful to beneficial insects.
