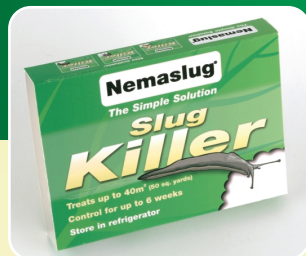

The Solution:



Nemaslug uses the nematode *Phasmarhabditis hermaphrodita* to control all common species of small to medium sized slugs (up to 8cm). Large slugs start off as small slugs, so apply early to kill them before they've grown by eating your plants. Within one week your plants will be protected, as the slugs will stop feeding. One application of Nemaslug will provide at least six weeks control of slugs. This is generally enough time for seedlings and bedding plants to get well established. For continued control, re-apply Nemaslug after six weeks.

- For outdoor applications, use from March to October when slugs are active (temperature should be above 5°C/41°F). Use year round for glasshouse applications.
- Soil or compost must be moist before and for at least two weeks after application, however, avoid waterlogging. Avoid applications in bright sunlight. apply during evenings or dull conditions.
- Using Nemaslug avoids unsightly chemical pellets on your garden and there are no slimy dead slugs to be found as the majority are killed beneath the ground.
- Nemaslug might affect water snails. To avoid harming them by keeping the treatment 15cm away from ponds.
- Nemaslug may be less effective in heavy clay soils as the nematodes have more difficulty moving around.
- Refrigerate upon receipt and use before the expiry date. Use entire pack at one time and do not store made up solutions.
- Apply Nemaslug using a watering can or a garden feeder. Just Green recommends the Miracle Gro® or Phostrogen® garden feeders.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR APPLYING NEMASLUG (40M² PACK)

- Add pack contents to 8 litres (2 gallons) of water. Stir to break up any lumps Take 2 litres (4 pints) of the mix, add to an 8 litre (2 gallon) watering can and fill with clean water.
- Using a coarse rose apply to 10m² (12.5 sq yds) of soil and water in with an equivalent amount of clean water.
- The pack fills 4 watering cans to treat a total of 40m² (50 sq yds). Stir the bucket before taking each 2 litres (4 pints).
